

# Parks Primary Kindergarten Supply List 2016-2017

These are the supplies your child will need for the school year:

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 mesh or "see through" backpack

\_\_\_\_\_ 1 blue and red Kindermat for rest time (NOT blue and green thick ones and NO YOGA MATS!)

\_\_\_\_\_ Optional: 1 cover for rest time (small blanket or small towel-NO PILLOWS!!!!)

\_\_\_\_\_ **\$35 Supply Fee** - Give to your child's teacher on testing day (All kindergarten students will be individually screened just before school begins. You will be notified of your child's screening date and time in August. PLEASE bring all requested supplies and supply fee to Open House on Monday, August 8 from 5:15-6:30 (floating open house))

**These are the supplies purchased with the \$35 supply fee by your child's teacher:** 12 plastic folders with brads, 1 pair blunt tip Fiskar scissors, 2 boxes large Crayola crayons, 4 boxes regular size Crayola crayons, 2 four oz. Bottles Elmer's SCHOOL glue, 6 glue sticks, 2 boxes "fat" washable Crayola markers, 1 pkg. of regular size yellow #2 pencils, 1 pkg. of skinny dry erase markers and fat dry erase markers, 1 pencil bag, 2 coloring books, 6 cans of Playdough brand playdough, 6 boxes of baby wipes, 1 roll of paper towels, 1 box Kleenex, 1 bottle of soap, 1 package of paper plates, 1 box quart size and 1 box gallon size slide Ziplock bags, 1 package of construction paper, 1 package index cards, 1 pack of paper, 1 manilla folder, and Art Supplies (paint, paint brushes, glitter, stickers, beads, noodles, wiggly eyes, foam pieces, etc)

\*\*\*Note: Specific brands are needed for many supplies because they work better, are easy to use, or last longer.)

## Helpful Hints:

Children in Kindergarten do not have to wear belts if their pants have elastic waists and no belt loops! You can remove loops from pants if they have some elastic and will stay up without the belt. Having no belt to keep up with will make life easier!

Shoes with Velcro fasteners will give your child the ability to be independent and keep him/her safe!
